Information leaflet and guidelines for diagnosis of learning disabilities

The Center for the Diagnosis of Learning Disabilities conducts assessments aimed at identifying the focal points of learning strengths and difficulties, recommending educational adjustments and, if necessary, proposing ways of assistance.

If you are a student or candidate for an international program who has previously been identified as learning disabled and needs scholastic support and test accommodations, it is recommended that you submit a valid assessment in the English language (from the past 5 years). If you can not produce a valid certificate, it is possible to undergo an assessment of learning functions in English at the Center for Educational Counseling at Tel Aviv University.

The process of evaluating the learning function of students in the international program who do not have a valid diagnosis from the past 5 years:

- 1. A preliminary questionnaire must be completed for the applicant (at the Department's office, Room 214, Mitchell Building).
- 2. If you possess previous diagnoses and confirmations and a printout of grades from the period of your university studies, you must bring a photocopied copy to the secretariat when booking the date for the diagnosis.
- 3. Internal diagnosis the diagnosis and the recommendations are valid at Tel Aviv University only. The price is NIS 1,100
- 4. Any student who wishes to undergo a diagnosis will be asked to sign a waiver of confidentiality form for the purpose of transferring his / her diagnostic summary report to the faculty, as well as a statement of commitment to the process and the diagnostic procedures.

Application submission process for students in possession of a valid diagnosis from the past 5 years:

- 1. A preliminary questionnaire must be completed for the applicant (at the Department's office, Room 214, Mitchell Building).
- 2. To attach a copy of the valid diagnosis forms.
 - It is important to know that the adjustments are determined according to the type and severity of the disability, as well as the accepted procedures at the Faculty.
 The Teaching Committee uses these adjustments as part of its considerations, but such do not obligate the Committee to act verbatim.

A diagnosis cancellation will be charged 10% of the payment amount. Cancellations will not be accepted within 24 hours prior to diagnosis.
