Years 3 + 4 at Columbia University's School of General Studies

Study from the core curriculum at Columbia University's School of General Studies and choose a liberal arts major such as:

- Biology

- Middle Eastern, South Asian and African Studies



Duration: 4 years

(2 years at Tel Aviv University and 2 years at Columbia University)

Structure

The BMus program is a performance-based curriculum that comprises the following fields of study:

- Individual Lessons
- Music Workshops
- Theoretical Courses
- Internal Elective Courses
- External Elective Courses

Academic integration tracks offer a distinctive educational path, allowing new olim to start their studies in English and complete them in Hebrew.

Run in cooperation with the Israel Student Authority, these programs include English-taught classes for the first year or two years, along with intensive Hebrew language studies.

* Eligible students receive funding from the Israeli Student Authority to cover part of the tuition fees. Hebrew classes are fully funded, and there is also an option to receive a dormitory allowance, subject to eligibility restrictions.

The tracks are designed to support olim students or students wishing to complete their degree in Hebrew.

Psychometric test results are not required for admission.

Admissions are handled through the Israeli Student Authority.

Tracks offered at Tel Aviv University:

BSc in Electrical Engineering

Students take a preparatory year in English before being formally admitted into the Electrical Engineering / Mechanical Engineering BSc program taught in Hebrew.

In this preparatory year, you will study:

- Advance-level Hebrew
- Technical courses in English: Calculus 2, Linear Algebra, and Classical Mechanics for Electrical Engineering

Upon passing each of the courses in the preparatory year with the required grade and GPA, students can be admitted into the regular-track BSc program taught in Hebrew.

BA in Management and Liberal Arts

Students enroll in the English-taught BA in Management and Liberal Arts and take the required program courses as well as Hebrew classes during their first year. After passing the Hebrew proficiency exam, students transfer to the Hebrew-taught BA in Management & Liberal Arts.



JEWISH LIFE ON CAMPUS

Food

All food on campus is kosher-certified. There is a wide choice of meat, milk, and vegetarian options.

Dorms

There is a Shabbat key to gain entrance to the dorms on Shabbat without using an electronic chip or card. Lights turn on automatically in the hallway, which is permissible and one does not need to worry about these lights on Shabbat. All students may request a mezuzah from maintenance.

Rabbi on Campus

TAU's on-site rabbinic couple, Eitan and Elana Philips have created a caring and inclusive environment for students wishing to observe a religious life on campus or learn more about Judaism. Their home, located just steps from the university, has become a hub for social activities, religious studies, and community building.

ARRIVAL & STAY

Dorms

TAU offers on-campus housing for international students at the Einstein and Broshim dormitories, which are both a short walk from campus.

There are a variety of options, from shared rooms to private apartments, all equipped with basic amenities. All dorms are gated and have 24/7 security.

Lowy International's housing prices include all bills and fees, i.e. electricity and water bills, city tax, and VAT.

Housing ranges from 700 USD to 1,250 USD per month (no meal plan).

Visas

International students generally must obtain an A/2 student visa to study in Israel, which can be secured through the nearest Israeli consulate. The Lowy International School provides guidance on this process.

Student visas generally do not permit students to work while studying, although some internships or part-time jobs may be allowed with special permission.

Health Insurance

All international students are required to have health insurance, and TAU offers a comprehensive, sponsored health insurance plan through a local provider. This plan covers medical services, including doctor visits, hospitalizations and prescriptions.

Health insurance may be included in the tuition package for international students, though please check with your program coordinator to ensure this is the case.

SCHOLARSHIPS AND PAYMENT OPTIONS

TAU tuition is significantly less expensive than US universities. Students can complete their undergraduate degree in three years and may continue directly to a master's program, completing both degrees in a total of four years.

UNDERGRADUATE ADMISSIONS: GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- A high school transcript GPA of 3.0 (minimum)
- English proficiency requirement
- Personal essay (not required for the Music BMus)
- Two letters of recommendation (not required for the Music BMus)
- CV
- Copy of valid passport
- Passport-style photo that will be used for your student ID card

ACTs and SATs are optional for TAU's Liberal Arts and Management and Liberal Arts BA programs. They are not required for the Music BMus.

Application fee (non-refundable): \$150

Important: Admissions to the Dual Degree Liberal Arts BA are through Columbia's School of Graduate Studies

Transfer Options

TAU welcomes transfer students who are currently enrolled in undergraduate programs at their home universities.

How to transfer to TAU

- Choose the undergraduate program best aligned with your interests
- Contact the program manager via email, attaching your most recent academic transcript

Transfer credits are evaluated on a case-by-case basis, considering factors such as the level and content of courses, accreditation of the previous institution, and grades achieved.

Transfer credits can be granted provided

- the courses align with TAU's curriculum,
- were taken at a recognized institution within 5 years before transfer to TAU,
- meet a minimum grade requirement

The maximum number of credits that may be transferred:

- Liberal Arts BA: Up to 65%
- Management and Liberal Arts BA: Up to 50%

TAU evaluates transcripts and may also grant transfer credits for coursework from GAP year programs or in certain cases from AP or IB courses provided all the requirements are met.
