<b>Credits per Study Period</b>	Normal workload: 30 ECTS credits per semester
<b>Credits per Course</b>	In most cases 5 or 6 credits
<b>Number of Courses per Study Period</b>	6 courses
<b>Number of Course Hours per Week</b>	Depending on the course, between 2 – 6 hours per week each
<b>Housing in Dorms</b>	Exchange students may apply for accommodation in a students' residence hall. In general, there is, unfortunately, a major shortage of rooms. That is why only part of the students can be accommodated in dorms. We recommend applying as early as possible for a room. As far as private accommodation is concerned students should also take into consideration to stay outside the city centre in the near surroundings. <b>Health Insurance Requirements</b>	Exchange students have to prove health insurance valid in Germany. Health insurance is not provided by the University, please see <a href="#">here</a> .
<b>Visa Information</b>	Please ask at the German Embassy or the consulate at least 2 months before your departure if you need a visa for your stay in Germany!
