Exchange students must be nominated by their home university. Please send the nomination form to elody.vincent@reseau-cd.fr

After receiving our confirmation, please ask your students to fill in the online application form and send the required documents to incoming@reseau-cd.fr : copy of ID valid passport, ID photo, most recent transcripts of records (with an English or a French translation), proof of language proficiency.

Students are required to provide a copy of their International Health Insurance Certificate (covering repatriation, civil liability and extra medical costs) as well as:

EU-residents : a valid copy of your European Health Insurance Card (EHIC)

Non-EU residents : a certificate proving that you applied for the French Health Scheme (Sécurité Sociale). It is mandatory and free.
