Application	<p>Nominated students should apply once their names are sent to Ashoka University through their international office.</p> <p>Link would be provided directly to the student/ s.</p>
Eligibility	<p>Must be enrolled as a full - time student at their home university</p> <p>Completed a minimum of 1 year of study at their home university (by the time he/ she starts at Ashoka)</p> <p>A cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above on a 4.0 scale; or its equivalent</p>
Application documents	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Updated CV/ Resume • Academic Transcript • Statement of Purpose • 1 Letter of Recommendation (LoR) from Faculty • Passport copy

Admission and Course Registration

Admission process	<p>Application form and documents are reviewed by the Office of Global Education team and acceptance letters are sent to students directly.</p> <p>Once the student accepts the offer, an invoice (for accommodation, meal plan & other costs) is sent.</p> <p>After the payment is received, a letter of visa invitation is sent from Ashoka University.</p> <p>Visiting Student Programme (VSP) email ID is generated for incoming students to proceed further.</p>
Semester course load	<p>You can choose maximum 4 courses (4 credits each) equivalent to 30 ECTS.</p> <p>Each 4-credit course involves 40 contact hours.</p>

	1 optional (2 credits) co-curricular course in performing arts/ visual arts/ languages.
Course registration	<p>VSP students can proceed with course registration once their Ashoka VSP email ID is generated in the system.</p> <p>Course catalog is visible to students a month prior to their semester starting date on Ashoka Management System (AMS).</p> <p>The Office of Global Education guides students in selecting courses and registering for the same.</p> <p>VSP students can choose courses as per their academic preference and availability.</p> <p>Note - Some courses have prerequisites. Incoming students need to provide evidence of prior knowledge of the topic to receive a waiver on prerequisites.</p>

Accommodation

Campus accommodation	<p>Ashoka University is a residential university, and all international visiting students are also guaranteed campus accommodation in fully-furnished residence halls with laundry service.</p> <p>Rooms are on a double-occupancy basis.</p> <p>We pair visiting international students with Ashoka students to encourage intercultural exchange.</p> <p>Note - Single room accommodation is not available.</p>
Meal plan	<p>Students receive a meal plan (buffet and combo meals) at the dining facilities of Ashoka. This is included in the fees structure.</p> <p>Note - Campus has additional food outlets, where students can purchase the same at their own cost.</p>
