In that case, these pre-requisites will be announced in the online application form under instructions. Additionally, some courses may also have pre-requisites that must be considered before making a selection. Insufficient background may result i course denial. • Hosting schools can only guarantee acceptance in their own courses. Enrolment in courses outside the hosting schools will depend on the spaces available after registering their own students.* • It is important to make sure that the selected courses are taught in the semester the student is to come. • When selecting courses students should bear in mind that EPSA and EPSG are located in the cities of Alcoy and Gandia respectively (around 80km from Valencia) • Class availability cannot be confirmed until enrolment once students have arrived in UPV. Students will have 10 days after the beginning of the semester to make changes in their course selection. *Some Schools may have very limited spaces due to huge demand. Enrolment at the Faculty of Business Administration and Management is very unlikely Please be aware that some programs or courses have access restrictions. Please notice that Schengen Visa is not issued with the NIE.
