Application Deadline(s)	Academic Year and Fall Semester : April 30 Academic Year and Spring Semester : October 30
Language Requirement	A proof of language proficiency is not required. However, being able to use either English or Chinese to communicate and take courses is necessary. *Most of the courses taught in English at NCU are in graduate level but allow junior and senior undergraduate to take. Therefore, an undergraduate student without Chinese Proficiency but with good English Proficiency should come to NCU for exchange on the 3rd year or 4th year of their undergraduate.

Required Application Documents	*The international office from partners send the nomination list to NCU first. Then, NCU will provide the password of the online system for each student. Apply Online (https://ncuies.ncu.edu.tw/) with following documents 1. Official Enrolment Certificate issued by Home University 2. Official Historical Academic Transcript issued by Home University (must contain GPA and please provide the grading system of the school) 3. Letter of Recommendation 4. Copy of Information Page of Passport 5. Head Photo: it should be in JPEG file and followed by the passport photo standard *All the documents should be written in English or Chinese. *Please note that the departments in the school of Management expects applicants to have 4 GPA (scale 5) and have taken at least 2 management related courses. *Please make sure the programs students apply for match their majors.
