



## Visiting Professor Initiative 2026-7

We are delighted to announce our seventh call for hosting visiting professors at TAU during the 2026-7 academic year. Visiting faculty will join our campus for part of the semester and teach in person an intensive academic course.

The visiting professor will be entitled to \$7,000 – 8,500 for expenses (this amount is meant to include honorarium, flights, and accommodation). The length of the visit would be 2-4 weeks. Please note that the full amount cannot be paid only as an Honorarium and must include expenses such as travel and lodging. Each TAU school is allocated funding for one visitor.

The level of support for the guests can be increased according to the following criteria. The total support cannot exceed \$8,500.

### Support Based on Visit Duration

Length of Stay	Additional Funding
Stay of up to two weeks	No additional funding
Stay of two weeks to one month	\$500 additional
Stay of over one month	\$1,000 additional

### Support Based on Flight Cost

Countries/Regions	Average Distance	Additional Funding
North America (USA and Canada)	10,000 km	\$500
Central and South America	10,000–12,000 km	\$500
Australia and New Zealand	13,000 km	\$750
Asia (Japan, China, Singapore, Korea, India)	4,000–6,000 km	\$300
Europe	200–600 km	No additional funding

Additional guidelines:

- The course taught must be for academic credit (at least 2 credits).
- Only visiting faculty that have not taught at TAU in the past three years are eligible. However, we may consider supporting again a course that was previously offered under this initiative and proven successful (served a relatively large number of students, course evaluations were strong, was innovative, etc.)
- We would like to emphasize that this initiative is intended to increase the scope of international activities on campus and not to cover existing visits that a school or faculty has already included in their annual plan.
