Visiting Professorships at the Collège de France

We are happy to announce a call for Visiting Professorships as part of the Academic Cooperation Program between Tel Aviv University (TAU) and the Collège de France (the Collège). The collaboration between the two institutions aims to promote reciprocal relations and facilitate the invitation of professors affiliated with TAU to the Collège.

Visiting Professors from TAU at the Collège

The professorships are open to all tenure and tenure-track TAU faculty. The duration of each professorship is flexible; it may vary from 3 to 12 months depending on individual needs and interests. The candidates involved in the exchange will seek to develop further research collaborations in domains of mutual interests, in any form they deem suitable. This can include in particular:

- Conferences, seminars and symposia of mutual interest
- Exchange of staff members for the purpose of research
- Establishment of joint research programs
- Exchange of scholarship produced by either or both of the parties, as well as the exchange of material on relevant and topical research undertaken by researchers of both institutions.

Financial

The Collège will provide each visitor with a pro rata stipend according to the duration of the stay, sufficient to cover meals and local transportation, in addition to providing accommodation.

TAU shall pay the cost of a round-trip economy-class airfare between TAU and Paris, for each of no more than three professors annually.

The selection committee will assess applications based on the following:

- Name, title, and proof of contact with a research partner at the Collège
- Letter of invitation from the hosting chair professor at the Collège
- Description of the planned activities
- CV and list of publications
- The options for the visit dates: from January 1 to December 31

Full health and accident insurances are mandatory for visitors.
