Join our two consecutive Arabic Beginners Courses (beginners 1 and 2), which combine two existing varieties of Arabic: Modern Standard Arabic (MSA), mainly used in written texts and formal settings, and colloquial Arabic (Palestinian Arabic, or PA), which refers to various spoken dialects used among different Arab countries and communities.

- Speaking and writing of both MSA and PA.
- Extracurricular activities including day trips and culutal activities organized and managed by Arabic native speaker councilor
- Multidisciplinary approach from History and Conflict resolution
- Class Discussions from diverse points of views and scholarly studies

STUDENTS WILL LEARN HOW TO:


- Understand the basic grammar and vocabulary of both MSA and PA.
- Understand and actively participate in simple conversations.
- Read and translate basic texts.

All while focusing on communication and developing proficiency in the language by using it in meaningful contexts: greetings, education, home and family, work, politics, and culture.

Alongside the Academic aspect, extracurricular activities will be offered such as: program specific day trips around Israel, cultural activities and moreorganized and managed by a native Arabic speaking councilor, offering the student an unmediated introduction to Israeli-Arab society.
