A VOYAGE TO MEDICINE IN ISRAEL

A FALL-SEMESTER STUDY ABROAD PROGRAM FOR STUDENTS WITH AN INTEREST IN MEDICINE



A FASCINATING LOOK AT THE FRONT LINES OF MEDICINE

A Voyage to Medicine in Israel is a fall semester study abroad program for pre-med and other health/science students. A collaboration between Tel Aviv University International and Assaf Harofeh Medical Center, the program offers a unique and educational experience. Participants take part in a combination of academic courses in medicine, practical experience in the medical field, and shadowing of the medical staff and clinical researchers at Assaf Harofeh Medical Center. In addition to the classes you will receive first-aid training by Magen David Adom (the Israeli Red Cross) and a trauma/life support course.

ACADEMIC CONTENT

The academic program is preceded by a mandatory intensive Hebrew language course, called an Ulpan, to prepare you for life in Israel. Following the Ulpan, you will take part in a week long intensive first-aid training offered by MADA (Magen David Adom) preparing you to provide Pre Hospital Trauma Life Support (PHTLS) while volunteering as an EMT throughout the program. While on the program, you will be required to take five academic courses, all taught by outstanding and experienced professors, doctors, and experts in the field.

- **Health and Psychology** (3 credits)
- **The Circle of Life – From Birth to Old Age** (3 credits)
- **Introduction to Clinical Laboratory in Medicine** (2 credits)
- **Introduction to Clinical Research** (2 credits)
- **Introduction to Exercise Physiology and Sport Medicine** (3 credits)

EMT EXPERIENCE

First-aid training by Magen David Adom (the Israeli Red Cross) and a trauma/life support course will prepare students for field experience by joining EMT teams in working ambulances in Tel Aviv.

CLINICAL RESEARCH

In collaboration with program staff, students choose a department (depending on availability) to join at Assaf Harofeh. Under the supervision of a physician, students shadow practicing physicians and researchers to gain insight into the field of modern medicine in practice.

ASSAF HAROFEH MEDICAL CENTER

Located in the center of Israel, Assaf Harofeh Medical Center is Israel's fourth largest government hospital. It operates one of the most active emergency services in Israel, with one of the largest numbers of trauma and accident admissions, comprising thousands of trauma patients.
