



Financial Aid: Ineligible Programs

The U.S. Department of Education certifies The Lowy International School's participation for student financial aid programs. To be eligible for financial aid the academic program must lead to a degree that is equivalent to a Baccalaureate (Bachelor) or Master degree awarded in the United States, must be at least a two-academic year program for a Baccalaureate and a one-academic year program for a Master's, does not offer distance learning, and does not extend to any joint degree program.

At the Lowy International School, there are some programs which are **NOT** eligible for financial aid. Below will be a list of all programs that are not eligible for federal financial aid.
